

Application Instructions

- 1. Download the YDG Application Manual & Instructions.
- 2. After carefully reading through the manual, pay a non-refundable application fee of GH¢ 200 at any Stanbic Bank in credit of the account details below:

Unfortunately, there is no mobile money payment for this application opening.

Please Note:

- Ensure that the Applicant's name corresponds with the Depositor's name on the deposit slip when paying at the bank.
- If you submitted your name, telephone contact and email address before downloading the Application Manual, you will receive an Email (with your application code) confirming receipt of your APPLICATION PAYMENT within 180 minutes of your deposit at the bank.
- The email confirming receipt of your payment will be issued with your YDG Cohort V Application Form to be completed and submitted via the YDG website.
- If someone else made a payment on your behalf and the person's name is captured on the deposit slip, please email a copy of the slip to applications@youngdiplomatsghana.org for verification. After verifying the payment, your application code and application form will be sent to you via email.

- If you issue a direct transfer from your account to the account number above, please use your name as the reference for the transaction. In addition, you must send an email with a screenshot or a receipt of the transaction to applications@youngdiplomatsghana.org. This will enable us to verify the payment and issue you your application code and application form.
- 3. Upon receiving your application form, review and answer all questions on the form. Proceed to submit your completed form on the Submit Application page on the YDG website. You must submit your resume and a photo of yourself with your application form. Check the application form for details.
- 4. Once your application is received, you will receive a response via email confirming receipt of your application within 24 hours.
- 5. All official communications on your application will be done through email. Do check your mail periodically to ensure you do not miss out on any communication.
- 6. The deadline for payment of the application fee is 18:00hrs on Thursday, March 14, 2024.
- 7. The deadline for submission of application is 18:00hrs on Monday, March 18, 2024.

Delegate Selection Process.

The YDG Delegate Selection process is competitive and strictly based on merit. A strong emphasis will be placed on the content of submitted applications this year. Applicants are encouraged to follow all application instructions, correct all grammatical errors, and provide compelling answers to application essay questions.

Technical Eligibility Requirement.

- Applicant must be a citizen of Ghana.
- Applicant must be 18 years or older but not more than 32 years old at the time of application.
- Applicant must be proficient in reading, writing, and speaking English.
- Applicant must be proficient in at least one local language.

Applicants who do not meet the above requirement will automatically be disqualified. Interested nationals of other African countries residing in Ghana should contact the application office at applications@youngdiplomatsghana.org for consideration.

The Selection Committees will, among others, assess an applicant's interest in diplomacy and international affairs, public policy, relevant professional experience where necessary, communication skills, leadership orientation, academic ability, and commitment to building a career in international relations, governance, nonprofit, social entrepreneurship, etc.







Cohort V Application.

YDG Cohort V application opens on Friday, March 1, and closes on Monday, March 18, 2024.

Application Fee.

The YDG Cohort V application process comes with a non-refundable fee of GH¢ 200 to be paid at a designated bank, as stated in the Application Instructions.

Duration for Cohort V.

The cohort would last eight months with monthly sessions and more hands-on work and interactions.

Commitment & Subscription Fee.

YDG Delegates are required to pay a commitment fee for their time with YDG. The fee to be paid by Cohort V Delegates will be communicated along with the notification on being selected as a Delegate for the cohort.
